The land has some slope and is served by a road that has no exit and serves as access to the property.

It has an excellent view over the city of Tomar and the Convento de Cristo, classified as a world heritage site by UNESCO.

The entire surrounding area is very calm and quiet, access to the property is reasonable and there are electricity, telephone and water connections beside the plot along the road.

This can be an excellent opportunity to acquire land with a fantastic location, where you can build your dream home, in a very special area of Portugal.

LOCATION:

The property is in 3 minutes the historical town of Tomar with the historic Convent of the Christ and Castle built by the Knights Templar in the 12th century and is classified as a World Heritage Site by Unesco.

To the Lake of the Dam of "Castelo de Bode" is only about 10 minutes away. This lake is popular for all kinds of water sports activities. The lake is also a paradise for wildlife with very pure water and there are several river beaches near the property where you can relax in the sun.

Access to the highway is about 5 minutes, where you arrive at Lisbon airport in an hour and a half, although it is possible to use the train or bus for this trip. The sea coast is about an hour and a half by car where you have beautiful beaches such as Nazaré, ideal for surf lovers and other sea sports.

Lisbon airport is served by several low cost airlines that operate scheduled flights between Portugal and the United Kingdom and other European countries.
